Supporting our Littles Beyond Our Mentoring Programs

Each year, Big Brothers Big Sisters supplies many resources outside of our traditional mentoring programs. We believe that every child who wants a mentor deserves one. 90% of the Littles we serve are either at or below the poverty line and quite often we are met with requests for a variety of needs. We strive to ensure the needs of our youth and families are being met in a holistic way. In addition to providing graduating Littles with a \$1,500 Scholarship, we annually award \$5,000+ to Littles and their families for additional needs such as groceries, gas, clothing and school supplies. The needs of our families grow each year and we are fortunate for the variety of foundations such as the Episcopal Charities of Rhode Island and the Billy Andrade-Brad Faxon Charities for supplying the necessary funds to ensure our Littles can reach their fullest potential.



Celebrating the Season with Welcome to Summer



This year Big Brothers Big Sisters celebrated our 9th annual Welcome to Summer event. Each year board member, Tom Furey, along with an amazing group of committee members and South County community leaders, celebrates the arrival of summer with a beach party at Bonnet Shores Beach Club. The Club generously opens its doors to the community for light beach fare and amazing music from some local favorite bands such as Brass Attack and Sugar. The event, since 2010, has raised \$200,000 for our mentoring program and for a handful of other local charities, all working towards providing the youth of our community with resources to be successful in their educational careers.

Building Up Our Youth, Building Partnerships and Building the Future!



In 2018, Big Brothers Big Sisters embarked on an explorative journey to launch a Beyond School Walls (BSW) Program with native Rhode Island company, Hasbro. BSW is a site-based mentoring program where mentoring happens between an elementary school and a corporation, business or club, during the school day. A BBBS staff member facilitates each weekly mentoring session, which includes curriculum in collaboration with the needs of the school district's learning initiatives. This past fall we were able to launch our newest site at Potter Burns Elementary School, where volunteer mentors from Hasbro joined students during their lunch hour to connect, and take part in facilitated STEAM curriculum.

Since our first site at Amgen was launched in 2015, we have served over 125 children through partnerships with Schneider Electric, Alex and Ani, National Grid and now Hasbro. Our sites have shown positive outcomes for the children, as well as increased employment engagement for the companies that participate.




